*The English Civil War—KS3 History*

It's 1642! The English Civil War begins.... Acting on 'the Divine Right of Kings' (believing he was a representative of God) the ruling King Charles I decides to rule the country without a Parliament. Marrying a Catholic Queen also angered Parliament, who were mostly Puritan (strict 'no-frills' protestants). Before you know it Oliver Cromwell (on the side of Parliament) has declared War on the King.
